### Queen Elizabeth - Important Information for schools

Following recent communication to schools from the DfE, I would like to share with you further considerations for schools.

- 1. A Public Holiday has been called for **Monday 19 September 2022** which is the day of the funeral. As this is during term-time all Schools will be closed on that day only.
- 2. School will be open and pupils in attendance for the rest of that week and any unauthorised absence during that week should be recorded as appropriate.
- 3. If you have a visit/residential/concert planned for that day and it will incur a cost to change or to cancel, then it will be for Governors to decide if the event goes ahead or not.
- 4. - 5. Memorials for flowers will be in place at Northwich Memorial Court, Ellesmere Port Civic Way, Winsford Wyvern House, and Chester Town Hall or Cathedral West Door.
- 6. Books of condolence will be open at the following locations Chester Town Hall, Wyvern House Winsford, Ellesmere Port Civic Way and Northwich Memorial Court.
