Water Safety Matters is a training company in Cheshire dedicated to training and educating young people in how to stay safe and make safe decisions.

Please can you share this information with your parents and pupils as they head off to enjoy the Christmas break

- · Always tell an adult where you are going
- Always stay together
- · Never venture out onto any frozen water as it may not be very strong
- · If a friend gets into difficulty throw something to them, don't try and rescue them
- Call 999 and ask for the fire service phones need to be charged and the call is free
- · If you fall into water, lie on your back and try and float by making a star shape.
